To thoroughly reconstruct a lift truck engine, a good company would first completely disassemble it. A heat cleaning system is then used to clean all of the parts. As soon as this step has been completed, all of the parts are checked to see if they have any extensive wear, any defects or breakage. Certain parts like crankshafts, cylinder blocks, connecting rods and cylinder heads are reground, resurfaced and resized if necessary. Other components like for example gears, nuts, bolts et cetera. are replaced or repaired as needed.

The engine is rebuilt manually when the overhaul has been finished. After putting it back together, a series of tests are applied to the running equipment. This is done so as to check all of the parts to guarantee there are no issues or leaks. If any problems occur, the needed alterations are done.
